# **Insights**

Last week, the Indian space agency Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO), successfully launched the Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV)-C55 mission, which received kudos globally, including congratulations from Elon Musk, CEO of Tesla and SpaceX. This launch marks ISRO's third major launch of the year and is an important landmark in India's space journey. In fact, India is one of the few countries that have built end-to-end capability in space technologies and is fast becoming an emerging space economy.

The Indian government announced wide-scale reforms to the space sector in 2020, followed by the Space Policy 2023, which outlines national efforts to increase India's share in the global space economy. The new policy opens up the space sector to the private sector and startups like Agnikul, Pixxel, and others, who are working on innovations, aiming to lower costs and improve efficiency in satellite launches.

As the entry of the private sector attracts more capital investment, space agencies conduct multiple orbital launches of rockets beyond just satellites, and the government focuses on the new Space Policy, India is all set to increase its market share in the global space economy by up to five times. A 2022 joint study by consulting firm EY and ISPA has estimated the sector to be worth US\$ 13 billion by 2025
