Advisory on Yellow Fever Vaccination

The Embassy of India, Lomé (Togo) wishes to inform that India has implemented stringent yellow fever vaccine entry requirements under the International Health Regulations (IHR) 2005.

Under IHR, travellers aged 9 months and older arriving from any of the 42 yellow fever endemic countries, including Togo, must possess a valid Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate (YFVC) issued by authorized vaccination centres upon arrival in India. This Certificate becomes valid 10 days after vaccination and, therefore, travellers must be vaccinated at least 10 days before their departure. Travellers without possession of a valid YFVC will be quarantined for a maximum period of 6 days at designated facilities as per IHR guidelines.

The World Health Organization has also mandated the need for nationals from the 42 yellow fever endemic countries to possess a valid Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate.
